Financially Solvent

This is a time to trust God and allow Him to provide for you and participate in the kingdom of God.



Risk Management

All mission trips and projects involve risk. We will never knowingly put you in a position where the risk is beyond your awareness.



Team leaders will provide required training tailored to your particular mission trip or project.

STEPS FOR JOINING A MISSION TEAM

First Baptist Church Bryan has a process to joining a mission team or project. We expect members at our church to participate in the worldwide missions movement. Take the first step by visiting fbcbryan.org/missions.

The following steps will begin the process for team selections:

- 1. Visit fbcbryan.org/missions.
- 2. Preview current trips.
- 3. Email or call team leader of the trip you are interested in.
- 4. A missions staff member/team leader will evaluate your interest and answer any questions you may have.
- 5. Once the evaluation is done, you will receive confirmation of selection.
- 6. Register with your 10% down payment.
- 7. When funds are available, the church with match your 10% down payment as a scholarship on your account.

Don't see an opportunity that's right for you?

WHAT TO EXPECT

Registration

Once a decision has been made for you to join a specific team you will receive a email verifying your status.

Purchase Passport & Visa

We encourage every person to own a passport. The passport cost and visa fees are not included in your team overall cost. You can apply to a team prior to securing a passport. If you own a passport please review it to make sure you have plenty of blank pages (a minimum of 4-5 pages when traveling internationally with multiple stops). Please also verify the expiration date of your passport, which should be 6 months beyond the date of return to the USA. You can apply for a passport at TAMU Global Engagement. Visit their website at https://global.tamu.edu/global_services/passports.

Team Meetings

All team meetings are required unless providentially hindered. These will usually be on Sunday afternoons or evenings. These are lead by the team leader.

Finances

All trips are to be financially solvent. Therefore a budget is approved prior to any mission trip or project. A budget generally consists of airfare, lodging, transportation, food, insurance, supplies and gifts. All mission trips are faith projects and everyone is expected to raise their own support.
