Summer: A Season for Shifting Gears

Whether you are in school, have children in school, or neither, our whole community feels the change. The roads are quieter, restaurants are less crowded, and the pace of weekly life often slows just enough for us to breathe a little deeper. As rhythms change, consider using this season to take a spiritual inventory. Ask the Lord what areas of growth, involvement, or obedience He may be inviting you into in the coming year. As we seek to "Make Jesus our All, and Share Him with All," here are a few possible next steps for this fall:

Re|Gen: A discipleship pathway designed to help you receive and respond to God's grace and live it out in your relationships. Consider ReGen for a deeper teaching on forgiveness, grace, or freedom in Christ—or if you find yourself struggling with the same patterns.

Journey Groups: If you hear others talk about an "abiding" relationship with Jesus and long to experience that more deeply yourself, this may be the next step for you. Journey Groups provide the opportunity to walk with a small group of women as you learn to abide with Christ together.

Mentoring: If you are already regularly engaged in worship and Bible study and feel led to invest in another woman's spiritual growth, mentoring may be a meaningful next step for you. Intentionally walking alongside a younger or newer believer as she grows in her relationship with Jesus.

Weekday Bible Studies: If you are looking to study God's Word in community with other women, we would love for you to join a weekday Bible study this fall. Multiple studies, meeting days, and times will be available.

MidWeek: *Understanding the Big Story of the Bible.* If you've ever felt lost in Bible study and feel like everyone else knows things you don't, this class is for you. In this course we will get familiar with the Big Story of the Bible to see how it all fits together, from Creation to Revelation.
